The 2005 Barolo Monfalletto is graceful and light on its feet in a very classic expression of La Morra Barolo. Crushed flowers, raspberries and spices emerge from this mid-weight, feminine wine. The Monfalletto offers lovely balance and class, with an elegant, refined finish that captures the essence of the wines from this part of the Barolo zone. This should be a relatively accessible Barolo at an early age. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2020.

The 2005 Barolo Enrico VI presents a deeply spiced, layered expression of Nebbiolo in its menthol spices, minerals and dark fruit, all of which are framed by firm, sturdy tannins. There is lovely density and richness to be found in the glass, and the wine continues to develop quite positively with air.

The Enrico VI is a bigger, more structured Barolo than the Gattera, but the flavors are also a touch more advanced, and it remains an open question as to which wine will reach full maturity first. This is another impeccable, beautifully balanced wine from Cordero di Montezemolo. The Enrico VI is made from the Villero vineyard in Castiglione Falletto.

Anticipated maturity: 2012-2022.

The 2005 Barolo Bricco Gattera is a very pretty, harmonious wine redolent of ripe, perfumed cherries, flowers, spices, licorice and minerals. The fruit remains fresh and vibrant through to the finish, where silky tannins leave clean, lingering sensations on the palate that invite a second taste. This is a very polished effort from Cordero di Montezemolo.
