ITALY Vibrant and linear, this wild red offers balsamic aromas tamed by cherry and rhubarb flavors, with gruff and assertive tannins.



92 Cordero di Montezemolo Barolo Monfalletto 2009 \$45 ITALY Wild, offering balsamic aromas tamed by cherry and rhubarb flavors, with tannins that remain gruff and assertive. Vibrant and linear, with a long aftertaste of cherry and underbrush. Best from 2015 through 2028. 3,500 cases made.—B.S.

90 Cordero di Montezemolo Barolo Bricco Gattera 2009 \$75

A rich, mineral-laden style, boasting flavors of iron- and graphite-singed cherry, raspberry and licorice. This is firmly structured and balanced, with light, dusty tannins marshaling the finish. Drink now through 2025. 450 cases made.—B.S.
