



**96 Cordero di Montezemolo 2007 Bricco Gattera (Barolo); \$80.** This is an exceptional wine that will leave a mark, and a memory, with those who drink it. It's irresistible because of its brilliant, but simple, philosophy. Traditional Nebbiolo tones of cola, licorice and pressed violets are set beautifully against modern tones of spice, chocolate and vanilla. It's the integration of these two extremes that make this Barolo so important. Imported by Omniwines Distribution. *Cellar Selection.* —M.L.

**94 Cordero di Montezemolo 2007 Enrico VI (Barolo); \$85.** Barolo Enrico VI is a gorgeous wine that oozes intensity, depth and impressive aromatic complexity. There is a modern twist evident here in the form of toasted nut and spice aromas, but true to the Nebbiolo grape, the wine also shows nuanced layers of hummus, cola and chopped mint. Drink after 2018. Imported by Omniwines Distribution. —M.L.

**94 Cordero di Montezemolo 2005 Gorette Riserva (Barolo); \$NA.** Gorette Riserva is a blockbuster wine with big oak tones of spice and toast in the background of vibrant aromas of red cherry, blackberry and cassis. What really sets this wine apart, however, is the plushness and richness of its finely textured mouthfeel. —M.L.
