Winery of distinction



Cordero di Montezemolo

The Cordero di Montezemolo winery and estate is rich in history, but the wine the family produces is even richer. WRITTEN BY STEPHANIE D'ANGELO

Belonging to the Falletti family for over six centuries, the Monfalletto estate, in the heart of Italy's Barolo region, produces the wines that have made Piedmont famous all over the world. Now the property of Giovanni and Enrico Cordero di Montezemolo, it was these two brothers' father, Paolo, who began producing and marketing the Piedmontese wines in 1940.

Today, the breathtaking property consists of 28 continuous green hectares that are being cultivated in every direction around the buildings situated on the hilltops. Following several years of restoration and expansion, the winery and farm have combined an age-old traditional structure with modern innovation, to create the perfect symbol and example of integrated architecture. Overlooking the prized stretch of land is a majestic cedar of Lebanon, planted in 1856, as a wedding gift to the original family. The tree is the vineyard's focal point, and can be seen from every vantage point within the surrounding Nebbiolo vineyards.

Producing over a dozen varieties of full-bodied red and white wines, some

of Cordero's favourites include: Dolcetto d'Alba, Barolo Enrico VI, and Langhe Arneis. The vineyard also produces a rich and intense grappa, as well as an acclaimed Barolo Chinato, aromatized and spiced to perfection.
